In order to better improve phosphorus use efficiency along the whole of its cycle, it is also at stake to better raise public awareness on this major issue, and rethink education and learning on this matter. Participatory research and co-learning will thus be central in this event. SPS 2014 will take place immediately after the 5th International Symposium on Phosphorus in Soils and Plants to be held in Montpellier from 26th to 29th August 2014, focusing on phosphorus nutrition in agroecosystems. You will thus have the opportunity to attend both events and be part of this unique **PHOSPHORUS week 2014**.
